

1. Introduction

This document records the outcomes of our current digital learning plan; including targets and the actions we will implement to meet the targets.

1.1 School Details:

- St. Nicholas' N.S. is a three teacher school on the outskirts of Adare. The school was established in 1814 and has been serving the community in and around Adare ever since. The original school building was part of the Augustinian Abbey and a new school building was erected on site and opened in 2008.

1.2 School Vision:

- At St. Nicholas' N.S. we wish to integrate digital technology as a tool for teaching and learning throughout the school.. We want to foster a positive attitude to digital technology. We wish that teachers and pupils experience enjoyment and satisfaction in learning. We want to encourage independent learning where the teacher facilitates and supports the pupil in their learning. We want to work collaboratively as a school community where we share our skills and knowledge. We aim that pupils will transfer from our school as confident and creative users of digital technologies.

1.3 Brief account of the use of digital technologies in the school to date:

- We use digital technologies for research and project work, taking digital photos, maths and literacy games, coding and using digital content from publishers
- IT is also used for home school communication, record keeping, payments, administration and recording assessment scores and plans
